Transportation Management Plan" (CTC)

In a January 26, 2022, letter, the MCC submitted comments on the Final Draft of the CTC to the Planning Commission. The Final Draft CTC represents a significant improvement to earlier versions of the Plan. The MCC recommends that after receiving comments by the Planning Commission, the Board of Supervisors adopt the CTC.

Following the BOS adoption of the CTC, a review by the SMC Planning Staff will result in proposed amendments to the LCP for the Midcoast. These proposed amendments will be submitted to the California Coastal Commission. The MCC looks forward to reviewing proposed amendments.

The value of the CTC to the Midcoast will be in the projects pursued for implementation over the next five years. Many SMC Departments, Caltrans, and other government agencies will need to coordinate and provide resources. The MCC looks to the Board of Supervisors to lead implementation by ensuring effective management and coordination across agencies and allocating adequate resources with regular updates to our community.
