Subject: Caltrans SR1 Traffic Operational Systems Improvements Project

In response to your inquiry of April 18th, the MCC has revisited its prior limited endorsement of Variable Message Signs (VMS) as part of the Caltrans SR1 Traffic Operational Systems Improvements Project. Based on community feedback since our letter of Nov. 18, 2020, and the removal of VMS from the adjacent Caltrans' SR 1 Multi-Asset Roadway Rehabilitation project, we now oppose any use of VMS in our area. Those signs do not fit the rural character of our area and consume a large roadway footprint.

We continue to support the technology proposed for traffic monitoring, with the expectation that it will lead to: shareable, current traffic data to be used in transportation planning Midcoast; a reduction in footprint for Caltrans equipment; and the introduction of broadband capability, as was mentioned in a recent Caltrans presentation.
