

Grabtown Gulch Roadside Parking - 10 to 20 Spaces



Most visitors come to Purisima from the Peninsula, particularly San Mateo and Half Moon Bay.






# **Drivers** struggle to find parking. **Cyclists** struggle with safety. **Transit users** struggle with service availability.






## Visitors' top 5 potential improvements would **improve parking** and **expand multimodal options**.




