A. Harvey Rarbach Half Moon Bay City Council

Half Moon Bay City Council High Priority Items

1. Coastal Skyway
2. Community Broadband

B. Mike O'Neil Liaison to the Board of Supervisors

1. Illiana Rodriguez was appointed to the new Assistant County Exec Office
2. The Board of Supervisors voted to stop assisting federal immigration authorities. Supervisor Ray Mueller voted "no" due to the provision not allowing

for an exemption for persons convicted of serious crimes. Supervisor Mueller confirmed that he is in support of the County's move to become a sanctuary county.

3. The Board of Supervisors will hold a study session on the Opioid and Fentanyl Crisis May 9th.
4. The County continues to recruit for the coastside county commissioners for the following commissions:

C. Commissioner Kathryn Slater-Carter San Mateo Co Harbour District

1. Harbor dredging will be delayed for 1 year due to permitting issues. The dredging project will need support from the County.

D. Carlisle Ann Young MWSD

1. May 1st and 9th are the dates for free tree chipping
2. May 13th is the deadline to cut grass on open lots. After the 13th the county may cut the grass and add the cost to the lots property tax
