Notes for MCC Meeting October 25, 2023

Education, Enforcement Removes Guns from People Under Restraining Orders

- The County <u>provided an update</u> on a targeted effort to get firearms out of the hands of people with domestic-violence, gun-violence and certain other civil restraining orders against them.
- A total of 168 firearms 67 rifles or shotguns and 101 handguns were surrendered to law enforcement or federal firearms licensed dealers in compliance with court orders.
- The Gun Violence Prevention Program targets a gap in California's efforts to reduce gun violence: while many laws are on the books, little funding often goes toward enforcement.
- The Board of Supervisors in October 2022 pledged \$2 million over two years to launch the local effort.

Flu Clinics and COVID-19 Vaccination

- County Health is recommending that everyone who is eligible get the seasonal flu vaccine and the updated COVID-19 vaccine. Vaccines are available from health care providers and local pharmacies. Use MyTurn to find a location near you.
